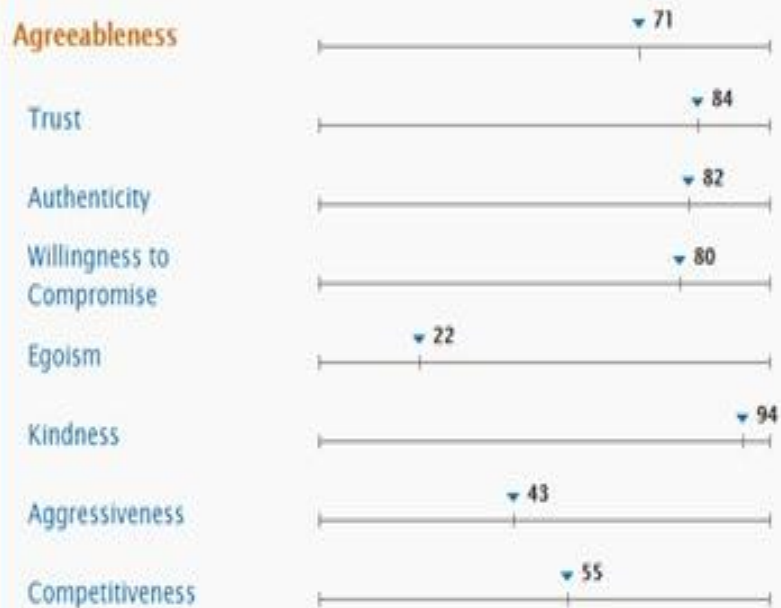

Resiliency (score 78)

Mary remains emotionally and mentally strong in the face of difficulties, criticism, and lack of support. She bounces back from hardship more easily than most, and has overall strength of character.

Ability to cope with adversity.

Anger Command (score 87)

Mary is not easily angered, as there is very little that truly outrages her. Instances that would infuriate many go practically unnoticed by her. When she does become angry, she likely controls herself very well. People who are unable to control their temper are often unpleasant to be around; therefore, this trait also affects Mary's score for the Agreeableness factor.

Impulse Command (score 81)

Mary is usually able to control and direct her impulses. She thinks through the possibilities and consequences before acting, and takes the time to make decisions. She is capable of resisting impulses and can delay gratification. Being impulsive can make others uncomfortable; therefore, this trait also affects Mary's score for the Agreeableness factor.

Self-confidence (score 86)

Mary has fairly high self-confidence. She takes pride in herself and her abilities, believes in herself, and behaves accordingly.
